Dear Attorney Rogers:

As you are aware, Father Dennis Keefe met with the Most Reverend Bishop Murphy in April 1998.

Father Keefe had been interested in discussing reinstatement or resignation issue with the church as you and I had previously discussed.

It is my understanding that did not occur.

In response to the Bishop's letter dated August 4, 1998, Father Keefe is not interested in seeking psychiatric counseling. He continues to assert his innocence in any accusation made against him. Father Keefe will continue to honor and follow the orders of the Archdiocese in all other respects.

Father Keefe would also like to resolve the situation in a mutually agreeable manner. It is again our suggestion that a reasonable resolution would be for the Archdiocese to reinstate Father Keefe to his full duties upon which Father Keefe would resign.
