

I represent of Mr. Mr. has informed us that he was sexually molested by you in the Fall of 1970 when Mr. was approximately fifteen years old. This abuse took place at your "office" in Roxbury, Massachusetts.

I have enclosed my letter of even date to Wilson Rogers, counsel for the Archdiocese. In this letter, my client sets forth his demands against the Archdiocese. By this letter, which is incorporated herein by reference, I am advising you that these demands are also hereby asserted against you. I would strongly suggest that you retain counsel immediately to represent your interest. If, after consultation, you desire to undertake a process to resolve these claims without litigation, then I would suggest that you have your counsel contact me. Mr. Roger's is in possession of a Tolling Agreement which we would like you to execute.
